



## Kanchenjunga North base camp trek - 16 Days

Kanchenjunga north base camp is a **trekking destination** in the eastern part of Nepal, located in the Kanchenjunga Conservation area. The area is covered with an abundant variety of wildlife the elusive snow leopard, red panda, the Asian black bear, and some of the more rare mammals. Bird lovers may get the chance to see the **golden-breasted Fulvettas, snow cock, and blood pheasant** among others.

**Kanchenjunga is the third highest mountain in the world**, and its base camp on the north side offers stunning views and a thrilling trekking experience. The route passes through several remote and less- visited areas, allowing you to experience the pleasing villages, lush forests, and **high mountains passes**. However, the trail involves steep ascents and descents, crossing rivers, and camping in remote areas with limited facilities.

The **north base camp** rewards trekkers with incredible panoramic views of the **Kanchenjunga massif**, including its main summit and other neighboring peaks. The remote landscapes, pristine **natural beauty**, and the sense of adventure make it a popular choice among the trekkers seeking a **unique and challenging** trekking experience in Nepal.

**Day 1: Arrive at Kathmandu and transfer to hotel**

**Day 2: Preparing for trekking**

**Day 3: Kathmandu to Bhadrapur (flight 43 min) - 297 m and Drive to Taplejung by Jeep (10 hours)**

**Day 4: Trek from Taplejung to Tapethok - 5 hours**

**Day 5: Trek from Tapethok to Amjilosa - 6 hours**

**Day 6: Trek from Amjilosa to Gyabla (5 hours)- 2730 m**

**Day 7: Trek from Gyabla to Ghunsa (5 to 6 hours)- 3550 m**

**Day 8: Trek from Ghunsa to Khambachen (rest day)- 4000 m**

**Day 9: Trek from Kambachen to Lhonak - 5 to 6 hours**

**Day 10: Trek from Lhonak to Pangpema (North Base Camp) - 5143 m**

**Day 11: Trek from Lhonak to Ghunsa - 6 hours**

**Day 12: Trek from Ghunsa to Amjilosa - 6 to 7 hours**

**Day 13: Trek from Amjilosa to Tapethok- 6 hours walk**

**Day 14: Drive to Bhadrapur by jeep**

**Day 15: Bhadrapur to Kathmandu flight- 1300 m**

**Day 16: Final Day at Departure to airport**
